NIDA requests all Deans and Directors to announce to our faculty members, staff and students to implement Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health's recommended prevention for COVID-19 based on <http://ddc.moph.go.th/vuralpneumonia/introduction.php> as the guidelines for conducting any educational activities within NIDA.

Faculty members, staff and students should consider postponing non-essential travels to above risk group countries until the situation has improved.

For essential and urgent trips please make adequate preparations of appropriate masks and sanitizers for good hygiene practice. Upon return to Thailand to comply with the screening process and others measures imposed by the Authorities.

NIDA will closely monitor the situation. Upon receipt of any updated notifications by the Ministry of Public Health and other related agencies. NIDA will take immediate action to comply accordingly to the appropriate measures announced.
