Guidelines for Students and University Personnel under Corona Virus 2019 (COVID-19)

Epidemic in Samut Sakhon Province

According to Ministry of Public Health's announcement regarding the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) epidemic in Samut Sakhon province on December 19, 2020, National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is announcing guidelines for students and personnel to prevent the spread of the epidemic.

Under authority of Article 35 and 40 based on National Institute of Development Administration Act. A.D. 2019, NIDA announces the following guidelines:

1. Students and personnel domiciling and residing in Samut Sakhon Province are required to refrain from traveling out of the province until January 3, 2021 or until announced otherwise by Samut Sakhon Province or the Ministry of Public Health.

Students and personnel not domiciling and residing in Samut Sakhon Province but who have traveled to Samut Sakhon Province from December 1, 2020 onward are obliged to stay at home for 14 days effective from the date of return.

In case of compulsory visit to Samut Sakhon Province, students and personnel not domiciling and residing in Samut Sakhon Province must report to the assigned faculty member or management depending on the case. After returning from Samut Sakhon Province, please stay at home for 14 days starting from the date of return.

The students and personnel close to or having been in contact with people domiciling and residing in Samut Sakhon Province or with those who have traveled to Samut Sakhon Province from December 1, 2020 onward, will be under the discretion of assigned faculty member or management depending on the case to consider whether students and personnel stay at home for observation. However, effectiveness and continuity of instruction and work should be taken into account.

2. Students and personnel with a fever or temperature more than 37.5 with any symptoms such as cough, sore throat, running nose, respiratory problems, dyspnea, tiredness, headache, ague, lack of appetite or other must immediately visit a doctor and stay at home for 14 days effective from the date symptoms first occurred.

3. Responsible sections and faculty members are requested to provide instruction, examination and evaluation for students in no. 1 and 2 according to NIDA's announcement in respect of Guidelines for Instructional Management under an Extraordinary Circumstance as a Result of COVID-19 Infection Outbreaks.

4. Personnel in no.1 and 2 are obliged to work from home according to NIDA's announcement with regard to work from home implementation under Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).

5. All NIDA's students and personnel must rigidly adhere to the Government's and NIDA's measures and guidelines to prevent the spread of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) epidemic such as practicing social distancing; wearing masks; measuring body temperature; washing hands with soap, alcohol gel or disinfectant; and having Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) assessment or filling in NIDA's form and submitting within mentioned deadline.
